A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, R. Lonnie Williams Place, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
R. Lonnie Williams Place	E. 104th Street	between Fifth Avenue and Madison Avenue

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
