SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Good afternoon and welcome to the Committee on Land Use.

At this time, we ask if everybody can please phones on vibrate or silent mode. Thank you.

Chair, we are ready to begin.

CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: [GAVEL] All right, good afternoon and welcome to the Committee on Land Use. I am Council Member Rafael Salamanca. I Chair this Committee.

I would like to welcome my Colleagues who have joined us today. We've been joined by Council Member Moya, Chair Louis, Chair Riley, Council Members Abreu, Brooks-Powers, Bottcher, Hanks, Krishnan, and Menin.

I would like to thank Chair Louis and Chair Riley for their work on our two Subcommittees.

Today, we will vote to approve items in all five boroughs. We are voting to approve LU numbers 264 and 265 for the 1460-1480 Sheridan Boulevard Proposal in my District in the Bronx. The proposal includes a

zoning map amendment and a related MIH zoning text amendment which together would facilitate a large mixed-use development along the Bronx River just south of Starlight Park with over 900 units of low-income and middle-income affordable housing and a publicly accessible waterfront esplanade.

We are voting to approve LUs 266 for an Article XI disposition approval related to Share NYC project on 106th Street in Deputy Speaker Ayala's District in Manhattan. This proposal would facilitate the development of a shared supportive housing building with approximately 32 affordable units under the City's Share NYC pilot program.

We are voting to approve LU 259 for the 2761 Plumb 2nd Street Rezoning in Council Member Vernikov's District in Brooklyn. The proposal consists of a zoning map amendment that would render a popular waterfront restaurant in Sheepshead Bay a legal conforming use and no longer require the renewal of a special permit every few years.

We are voting to approve with modifications LUs 260 and 261 for the 42-18 31st

Avenue Rezoning in Council Member Won's District in Queens. The proposal includes a zoning map amendment

We are voting to approve LUs 262 for the 125th Greaves Lane Proposal in Minority Leader Borelli's District in Staten Island. The proposal consists of a zoning map amendment to map a commercial overlay that will render existing uses lawfully nonconforming.

Finally, I make a motion to file LUs 253 and 254 for the 1233 57th Rezoning Proposal to remove these items from the Council's calendar. The proposal was withdrawn by the applicant on September 5th.

Therefore, pursuant to Council Rule 11-60(b), the associated LU items are void.

Now, we will take any remarks or comments from Members of the Committee.

Seeing none, I will call for a vote to approve LUs 259, 262, 264, 265, and 266, and to approve with the modifications I have described LUs 260 and 261, to file LUs 253 and 254.
