A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Highland Boulevard-Vito P. Battista Boulevard, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following street name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Highland Boulevard-Vito P. Battista Boulevard	Highland Boulevard	from Fanchon Place to Robert Place

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
