A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Ronald I. Jacobowitz Place, Borough of The Bronx.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

<u>New Name</u>	<u>Present Name</u>	<u>Limits</u>
Ronald I. Jacobowitz Place	Kossuth Avenue	between East 208th Street and East Mosholu Parkway North

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
