Today, we are voting on two proposals.

First, we will vote on LU Numbers 422 and 423

regarding the 1720 Atlantic Avenue Rezoning Proposal

in Council Member Ossé's District on the border of

the Bed-Stuy and Crown Heights neighborhoods in

Brooklyn. Applicant is seeking to develop a mixed-use

Next, we will vote on LU numbers 429 and 430 concerning the 1551 Broadway Midtown Signage Text Amendment in Council Member Bottcher's District.

Applicant is seeking to replace existing advertising signs in Times Square with more modern panels. The proposal involves two actions. The first is a zoning text amendment to create a new special permit for small zoning lots, and the second action is the actual application for a special permit. The special permit would allow the applicant to install a modern
