A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Kosciuszko Street, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Kosciuszko Street	Kosciuszko Street	between Bushwick Avenue and Bedfored Avenue

- § 2. This local law shall require the change in this street name to be indicated on the city map.
