### <u>Int. 54-A – Local Law 27</u>

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of city of New York, in relation to the use of alternative fuels and alternative fuel technologies in the city ferry fleet.

#### <u>Int. 880-A – Local Law 28</u>

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of city of New York, in relation to the use of biodiesel fuel in school buses.

#### Int. 1036-A – Local Law 29

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of city of New York, in relation to the census of vacant properties.

### Int. 1039-A - Local Law 30

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of city of New York, in relation to city-owned vacant properties that may be suitable for the development of affordable housing.

### Int. 1465-A - Local Law 31

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of city of New York, in relation to phasing out the use of residual fuel oil and fuel oil grade no. 4 in boilers in in-city power plants.

# Int. 1629-A - Local Law 32

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of city of New York, in relation to requiring periodic recommendations on adoption of more stringent energy efficiency requirements for certain buildings.

## Int. 1632-A - Local Law 33

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of city of New York, in relation to energy efficiency scores and grades for certain buildings.

## Int. 1241-A - Local Law 34

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of city of New York, in relation to diaper changing accommodations.
