A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a triangle name, The Father Patrick Kenny Triangle, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following triangle name is hereby designated as here-after indicated.

New Name	Present name	Limits
The Father Patrick Kenny Triangle	(none)	a triangular area located between East 68th Street and East 69th Street and between Avenue T and Veterans Avenue

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
