A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a street name, Main Street, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
Main Street, [Roosevelt Island]	None	On Roosevelt Island, approximately between the easterly prolongation of the northerly line of East 64th Street and the easterly prolongation of the northerly line of East 72nd Street, both in the Borough of Manhattan.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
