- SLR 0034-2004** State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Maltese, S.2936-A, and Assembly Member Abbate, et al, A.5915-A, “AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the crediting of prior service by the police pension fund of such city”.
