SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Good afternoon. Welcome to the New York City Council vote on the Committee on Land Use.

At this time, please silence all electronics and do not approach the dais.

Chair, you may begin.

CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: Thank you. [GAVEL]
All right. Good afternoon, and welcome to the
Committee on Land Use. I am Council Member Council
Member Rafael Salamanca. I Chair of this Committee. I
would like to welcome my esteemed Colleagues who have
joined us today. We've been joined by Council Members
Moya, Chair Riley, Majority Whip Brooks-Powers,
Majority Leader Farías, Council Member Hudson,
Sanchez, and Minority Leader Ariola.

Today we are voting on five proposals referred out to us by our Subcommittees, and as always I would like to thank Chair Riley and Chair Hanks for their ongoing leadership.

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riist, we will vote on hos number 403 and
406 regarding the 58 Nixon Court Rezoning Proposal in
Council Member Brannan's District in Gravesend,
Brooklyn, to develop a mixed-use residential building
with approximately 19 apartments, of which
approximately six would be permanently affordable. We
will vote to amend the zoning map for the project
area to an R7A district with a C2-4 commercial
overlay within the Special Ocean Parkway District
together with the zoning text amendment to map a
Mandatory Inclusionary Housing area. Council Member
Brannan supports these applications.

on LUsNnumbers 407 and 408 concerning the 464
Ovington Avenue Rezoning Proposal also located in
Council Member Brannan's District in Bay Ridge,
Brooklyn. The project seeks a development of a 40unit residential building, of which approximately 10
will be permanently affordable. We will vote to
approve the zoning map amendment to map a residential
R6A residential district within the Bay Ridge Special
District, as well as a zoning text amendment to map a
Mandatory Inclusionary Housing area. Council Member
Brannan supports the application.

Next, 5502 Flatland Avenue. Next, we will
vote on LUs Numbers 409 and 410 concerning the 5502
Flatlands Avenue Rezoning in Council Member
Narcisse's District in the Bergen Beach neighborhood
of Brooklyn. The proposal involves two actions. The
first is a zoning map amendment to change the
existing R3-2 residential district to an R6A
residential district with a C2-4 commercial district.
The second action is a zoning text amendment to map a
Mandatory Inclusionary Housing area. The applicant
seeks to develop a commercial building on the project
site. As explained by Chair Riley in the Zoning
Subcommittee this morning, we are voting to modify
the proposed R6A residential district to an R6B while
maintaining the CPC approved commercial overlay
district and modifying the MIH Option to remove
Option 1 and 2 and allow Option 3.

Next, 699-703 Lexington Avenue. We will vote on LUs Numbers 424 and 425 concerning the 699-703 Lexington Avenue Rezoning in Council Member Ossé's District in Bed-Stuy, Brooklyn for the development of 85 units of transitional housing. We will vote to approve an amendment to the zoning map to an R6A residential district and a zoning text

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amendment to map a Mandatory Inclusionary Housing area. We will modify the MIH Options to deepen the required level of affordability by removing Option 2 and adding Option 3. Council Member Ossé supports this application with the proposed modifications.

AAMUP follow-up. Our last vote concerning
LU 428 which is a follow-up action to the
neighborhood study and rezoning known as AAMUP that
we approved earlier this year. We are approving a tax
amendment to the newly created Atlantic Avenue MixedUse Special District to tailor the floor area bonus
for certain industrial uses within the mixed-use area
of the district to promote users engaged in
industrial, art-related, and other community-centered
uses. Council Member Hudson supports this
application.

Now I would like to recognize any of my Colleagues to wish and to make any remarks.

I would also like to recognize that we've been joined by Council Member Abreu.

I will now call for a vote with the support of the local Members to approve the modifications LUs 409 and 410 related to the 5502 Flatlands Avenue Rezoning Proposal; LUs 424 and 425

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2	related to the 699-703 Lexington Avenue Rezoning
3	Proposal; and to approve LUs 405 and 406 related to
4	the 58 Nixon Court Rezoning Proposal; LUs 407 and 408
5	related to the 464 Ovington Avenue Rezoning Proposal;
6	and LU 428 related to AAMUP follow-up action.
