2 SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Mic check, mic check.

3 This is a mic check on today's vote on Transportation
4 in the Chambers. Today's date is February 13, 2025,
5 recorded by Walter Lewis.

6 SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Quiet, please. Good
7 morning. Welcome to the New York City vote on the
8 Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

9 Please silent all electronic devices at
10 this time.

11 Chair, we are ready to begin.

12 CHAIRPERSON BROOKS-POWERS: [GAVEL] Good
13 morning. This is the Committee on Transportation and
14 Infrastructure. I am Selvena Brooks-Powers, the Chair
15 to this Committee. Today, we will be voting on
16 Proposed Intro. 552-A, sponsored by Council Member
17 Justin Brannan, a local law in relation to the street
18 resurfacing timeline, and Proposed Intro. Number
19 1160-A, also sponsored by Council Member Brannan, a
20 local law in relation to repainting of pavement
21 marking lines.

22 Proposed Intro. Number 552-A would call
23 on the Department of Transportation to complete all
24 street resurfacing work within 15 business days of
25 the completion of milling. If it is impractical to

2 complete the work within that time, the Department
3 must provide notice on its website as well as
4 directly to the affected community boards via email
5 with information about the reason for the delay and
6 the new expected date of completion.

7 Proposed Intro Number 1160-A would
8 require that the Department of Transportation, where
9 practicable, ensure that pavement markings or
10 temporary pavement markings are installed on a street
11 within five business days of street resurfacing. The
12 Department will be required to report on their
13 performance, including the number of streets where
14 paving markings have been installed, the percentage
15 that were completed on time, and if there were delays
16 and the reason for the delays.

17 I will now ask the Committee Clerk to
18 conduct a roll call vote on the legislation.

19 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Good
20 morning, William Martin, Committee Clerk. Roll call
21 vote, Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
22 Both items are coupled. Chair Brooks-Powers.

23 CHAIRPERSON BROOKS-POWERS: I vote aye.
24 Congratulations to Council Member Brannan. This is a
25 very much needed bill. We've seen it as recently as

2 the repaving on Cross Bay Boulevard that was
3 disastrous, and we hope that with these legislations
4 we will be able to work more closely with DOT, have
5 them accountable, and see a smoother process going
6 forward.

7 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Rivera.
8 Louis.

9 COUNCIL MEMBER LOUIS: I vote aye.

10 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Thank
11 you. De La Rosa.

12 COUNCIL MEMBER DE LA ROSA: Aye.

13 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Farías.

14 COUNCIL MEMBER FARÍAS: I vote aye.

15 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Thank
16 you. Narcisse.

17 COUNCIL MEMBER NARCISSE: Aye.

18 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Won.

19 COUNCIL MEMBER WON: Aye.

20 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Banks.

21 COUNCIL MEMBER BANKS: Aye, and
22 congratulations, Justin, and happy to definitely be a
23 sponsor on this bill. Thank you.

24 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Ariola.

25 COUNCIL MEMBER ARIOLA: I vote aye.

2 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: With a
3 vote of eight in the affirmative, zero in the
4 negative, and no abstentions, both items have been
5 adopted by the Committee.

6 CHAIRPERSON BROOKS-POWERS: With that,
7 this vote is recessed pending attendance of other
8 Committee Members.

9 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN:
10 Continuation roll call, Committee on Transportation
11 and Infrastructure. Proposed Introductions 552-A and
12 1160-A. Council Member Rivera.

13 COUNCIL MEMBER RIVERA: I vote aye.

14 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Thank
15 you. Final vote is now nine in the affirmative, zero
16 in the negative, and no abstentions. Madam Chair,
17 that is a full Committee.
