Every time something is in the District that the community really need affordable housing, 70 to 80 percent AMI is not affordable, and Howard houses development really right across the street. This project at least should be 60 percent AMI. And with the audacity with this HPD saying that subject to change, and I'm letting my community know subject to change is that
