Section 1. Section 3 of Local Law No. 45 for the year 1992, as amended by Local Law No. 47 for the year 1993, by Local Law No. 16 for the year 1994, and by Local Law No. 51 for the year 1995, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- §3. This local law shall take effect immediately and expire on June 30, [1996] 1997.
- §2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
