A LOCAL LAW

In relation to a corner name, Max Gordon Corner, Borough of Manhattan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following corner name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New Name	Present Name	Limits
Max Gordon Corner	(none)	the corner formed by the westerly line of Seventh Avenue South and the easterly line of Waverly Place

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
