A LOCAL LAW

To amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the amount charged to owners for sidewalk reconstruction.

Be in enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-152 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new subdivision q to read as follows:

- q. Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of this section, the amount charged an owner for sidewalk reconstruction performed or caused to be performed by the department in connection with a city capital construction project for street or sewer reconstruction shall be determined according to the average city expenditure for such sidewalk reconstruction projects in the borough where such reconstruction is performed. Such average expenditure shall be computed by the commissioner.
- §2. This local law shall take effect immediately and shall apply to amounts stated in notices of account mailed by the city collector pursuant to subdivision i of section 19-152 of the administrative code on or after such effective date.
