- T2004-0789** Oversight - Violent Video Games
- Int 0018-2004** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the sale of violent video or computer games to minors.
- Int 0060-2004** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the commercial display of video or computer games.
- Res 0010-2004** Resolution calling on the entertainment industry and retailers to enforce the ratings system for the sale of violent video games.
- Res 0012-2004** Resolution calling upon the video game industry to modify its voluntary, content-based rating system to include the placing of parental advisory labels on computer and video game packaging, promotions and commercial displays.
- Res 0015-2004** Resolution calling upon the Council of the City of New York to denounce the selling of "Grand Theft Auto: Vice City," a violent and racist video game which advocates the killing of Haitians and Cubans as entertainment, and calling on all concerned citizens to support an economic boycott of the video game's maker, Rockstar Games Inc., and its parent company, Take-Two Interactive Software.
