- T2024-2004** Oversight - Preparing Asylum Seekers and Migrants for the Workforce.
- Int 0216-2024** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to enhancing the IDNYC application process
- T2024-2094** A Local Law to amend the New York city charter, in relation to a job bank for individuals with federal employment authorization
- Res 0230-2024** Resolution calling on the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) and the Secretary of Homeland Security to grant humanitarian parole, of at least two years, to asylum seekers who entered the United States prior to the date this parole is announced.
- Res 0235-2024** Resolution calling on United States Citizenship and Immigration Services to quickly clear the backlog of I-765 applications for employment authorization.
- T2024-2113** Resolution calling on the New York State Legislature to pass, and the Governor to sign, S.5964/A.8263, also known as the Empire State Licensing Act, which provides all New Yorkers with access to professional, occupational, commercial, or business licenses, permits, certificates, or related registrations regardless of an applicant's citizenship or immigration status, or lack thereof
