- Int 0131-2018** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York and the New York city building code, in relation to curb cuts
- Int 0285-2018** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the department of transportation to clean and maintain all medians at least once a year and to create a web-based tracking system
- Int 0327-2018** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring curb extensions at certain dangerous intersections
- Int 0329-2018** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the condition of bridges, sidewalks and ferries.
- Int 0330-2018** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the department of transportation to report a list of all the sidewalks under its jurisdiction.
- Int 0438-2018** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to authorizing the painting of curb cuts
- Int 0939-2018** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to prohibiting the New York City police

department from issuing a violation to a vehicle for illegally parking in a driveway without first confirming the legality of such driveway

- Int 0953-2018** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to placing greater regulations and restraints on the creation of driveway curb cuts, and providing local community board notification
- Int 1015-2018** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the department of buildings to notify police precincts of complaints regarding illegal curb cuts
- T2018-1956** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the curbs adjacent to a fire hydrant or bus stop
