State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass a bill introduced by Assembly Member Mayersohn, A.9543, "AN ACT authorizing the city of New York to reconvey its interest in certain real property acquired by in rem tax foreclosure in the borough of Queens to the Arya Spiritual Center, Incorporated, notwithstanding expiration of the two year period within which application may be made to the city to release its interest in property thus acquired; Block No. 9592, Lot No. 95 on the tax map for the borough of Queens".

State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass a bill, introduced by Senator Hevesi, S.6246, "AN ACT authorizing the city of New York to reconvey its interest in certain real property acquired by in rem tax foreclosure in the borough of Queens to the Arya Spiritual Center, Incorporated, notwithstanding expiration of the two year period within which application may be made to the city to release its interest in property thus acquired; Block No. 9592, Lot No. 95 on the tax map for the borough of Queens."

- SLR 0196-2000** State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Spano, S.5714-A, and by the Committee on Rules, A.8139-A "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the application of the age fifty-seven retirement program, the mandated physically taxing program and the incumbent fifty-five/twenty-five program for certain employees and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof".
- SLR 0217-2000** State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Goodman, S.5760-A, and Assembly Member Vitaliano, A.6742-A, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York and the retirement and social security law, in relation to the distribution of accidental death benefits".
