Resolution denouncing the City Human Resources
Administration policy of impoverishing elderly New Yorkers
whose spouses receive Medicaid-provided nursing home or
home health care, even though it is not required to do so under
the current Medicaid law; calling upon the state to humanize its
fair hearing process and to relax its standards for increasing the
maximum level of savings and income an individual may retain
when his/her spouse is receiving nursing home care through
Medicaid; and calling upon the United States Congress to
amend the Medicaid Act to ensure that moderate income
individuals are not forced into poverty when their spouses need
nursing home or home health care.
