Res 0094-2002

Resolution calling upon the New York State Legislature to adopt Assembly Bill A.4886 and its companion bill, S.2614, which would amend Section 422(1)(a) of the Real Property Tax Law, in relation to providing real property tax exemptions to not-for-profit corporations seeking to construct affordable assisted living facilities for seniors with low to middle incomes.

Res 0133-2002

Resolution calling upon the New York State Legislature and the Governor to enact legislation to amend the Real Property Tax Law, in relation to indexing to inflation the maximum income allowed for persons occupying rental units to be eligible for the senior citizen rent increase exemption (SCRIE) program.

Res 0143-2002

Resolution calling upon the New York State Legislature to pass Assembly Bill 4227 and its companion Senate Bill 2334 to amend the Real Property Tax Law, in relation to increasing the allowable maximum income of persons occupying rental units otherwise eligible for tax abatement in certain cases.

Res 0146-2002

Resolution calling upon the New York State Legislature to pass Assembly Bill A607, which would amend the Real Property Tax Law to exclude from the definition of income all medical and prescription drug expenses actually paid by a senior citizen which were not reimbursed or paid for by insurance, for purposes of determining eligibility for the Senior
