Oversight - A Fair Share for New York City: A Case for Equity

Res 0865-2003

Resolution calling upon the United States government to enact that portion of the United States Senate-adopted version of the President's economic stimulus package providing for \$20 billion in state and local fiscal assistance, as well as to enact a national anti-recessionary revenue sharing program that would provide states and cities with direct federal assistance to mitigate the loss of revenues and increased service obligations during this current economic recession and other such recessions in the future.

Resolution commending the United States government for taking threat information, critical infrastructure and population density into consideration when distributing homeland security and bioterrorism funding, and further calling upon the United States government to continue to account for such factors when distributing additional homeland security and bioterrorism funding and to distribute such funds directly to the City of New York and other high-risk localities across the nation.

Resolution calling upon the Federal Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to reverse its decision to promulgate rules requiring the

working poor to meet a higher standard of proof of eligibility for the Federal Earned Income Tax Credit than it requires for other tax benefits, and, if the IRS fails to reverse itself, calling upon Congress to act legislatively to stop the proposed action.
