- Res 0372-2006 Resolution to establish that the interest rate be 18% per annum for Fiscal Year 2007 for non-payment of taxes on properties with an assessed value of over \$80,000, or over \$80,000 per residential unit for cooperative apartments. *Preconsidered*
- Res 0373-2006 Resolution to establish that the interest rate to be charged for Fiscal Year 2007 for non-payment of water rents and sewer rents be 18% per annum for real property where the assessed value is over \$80,000, or over \$80,000 per residential unit for cooperative apartments; and 9% per annum for real property where the assessed value is not more than \$80,000, or not more \$80,000 per residential unit for cooperative apartments. *Preconsidered*
- **Res 0365-2006** Resolution calling upon the New York State Legislature to pass Assembly Bill 7577 and Senate Bill 4795-A which would exempt contributions made by an employer to an accident or health plan for the benefit of an employee's domestic partner from State and City taxes.
