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- SLR 0007-2007** State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Padavan, S.61, and Assembly Member Clark, A.26, “AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to a fine for parked or unattended semitrailers or trailers on streets of a city with a population of one million or more”.
- SLR 0030-2007** State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Padavan, S.2414, and Assembly Member Seminerio, A.4529, “AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the crediting of prior service by the fire department pension fund of such city”.
- SLR 0038-2007** State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Lanza, S.4239, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.7336, “AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to the suspension of certain employees in cities having a population of one million or more”.

Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Padavan, S.3315, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.5781, "AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to suspension of employees of the department of parks in cities having a population of one million or more".

**SLR 0052-2007** State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Smith, S.1861, and Assembly Member Cook, A.3548, "AN ACT authorizing the city of New York to reconvey its interest in certain real property acquired by in rem tax foreclosure in the borough of Queens to former owner Morris Brown Church, notwithstanding expiration of the two year period within which application may be made to the city to release its interest in property thus acquired; Block No. 12048, Lot No. 85 on tax map for the borough of Queens".

**SLR 0056-2007** State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Maltese, S.5382, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.4465, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to health insurance coverage for surviving spouses of members of the fire department engaged in performing emergency medical services in the city of New York who are enrolled in a health insurance plan".

**SLR 0060-2007** State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Padavan, S.3994, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.6542, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the employment of retired New York city police personnel".

**SLR 0062-2007** State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Padavan,

S.2486, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.4704, “AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to accidental disability for certain members of the New York city employees’ retirement system or the New York city board of education retirement system”.
