The next item relates to the adopted Fiscal 2011 Expense Budget which we adopted on June 29th. Generally, this transparency resolution makes mostly technical corrections to the designations that were listed in Schedule C. The resolution also makes changes to designations made in 2010 and 2009.

Additionally, as with all transparency resolutions, Council Members will have to sign a disclosure form indicating whether or not a conflict exists with any of the groups on the attached list. If any Council Members have a potential conflict of interest with any of the organizations listed, they may want to disclose the conflict at the time before they vote, just making clear on what the conflict is on the
