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CHAIRPERSON CORNEGY: Good morning. Good morning, everyone, and thank you for coming. I'm Council member Robert Cornegy, Junior, Chair of the Council's Committee on Housing and Buildings. We're here to hold the vote on a package of four bills related to construction safety. Proposed Intro number 2262-A, sponsored by me, does two things: First, it streamlines certain sign off processes by removing the requirement for final inspection for temporary construction equipment permits. Second, it prohibits the installation and use of stand off brackets which have been identified by DOB as a contributing factor in scaffolding incidents and injuries. Proposed Intro number 2263-A, also sponsored by me, amends the definition of a major building. Under the old definition, a major building was defined as one that is 10 stories or more or 125 feet or more. Under the new definition, those thresholds are lowered to seven or more stories or 75 feet or more, respectively. The amended definition would trigger additional site safety requirements on more construction sites. Proposed Intro number 2264-

A, also sponsored by me, amends certain existing
requirements and establishes new requirements for th
use of cold formed steel light frame construction.
Although cold formed steel is widely used in many
different construction applications, when used or
installed incorrectly, it can pose a safety hazard.
This bill would help to ensure the safe use of this
material, codifying and building on what has already
been done by DOB bulletins. Lastly, the committee
will vote on proposed Intro number 2276-A, sponsored
by Council member Moya. This bill expands the
requirements of local law 196 for the year 2017 by
requiring additional site safety supervision and
major building construction sites. This bill
requires the designation of primary construction
superintendents, building on efforts to reduce
construction-related injuries and fatalities. I'm
joined by Council member Grodenchik, Council member
Gjonaj, Council member Chin, Council member Cabrera,
