2	CHAIRPERSON DILAN: Good morning,
3	everybody. I'm going to try to do this as quickly
4	as I can because of the tight space requirements

we have with City Hall being under construction.

My name is Erik Martin Dilan and I'm the

chairperson of the City Council's Housing and

Buildings Committee.

Today, the committee will conduct a hearing for the purpose of a vote on Proposed

Intro 87-A, which is sponsored by a member of the committee, Council Member Melissa Mark-Viverito of Manhattan.

This bill would require that part of the annual multiple dwelling registration statement filed by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development, that corporations or partnerships that own a multiple dwelling to include more information about the principle owners of such a corporate entity or partnership. The bill also prohibits of mail drops for the purpose of registration.

Following the initial hearing that we had earlier this year, the following amendments were made to the original version of the bill.

The bill's section 2 was amended to provide that a
United States Postal Mail Service delivery box, a
mail delivery box maintained through a privately
operated mail handling facility or address at
which any such similar service is provided may be
included on a property registration statement,
provided that such address is not the only
business address listed on such statement. The
bill previously prohibited the use of such
addresses.

The last amendment is the enactment date that was amended to reflect that this bill will now take effect on January 31st of 2011, as opposed to 90 days after the enactment of this bill by the Council later today.

I urge my colleagues to vote yes on this information. If the bill sponsor would like to make a brief statement, I'd acknowledge her now.

## COUNCIL MEMBER MARK-VIVERITO:

Thank you, Mr. Chair. Yes, as you indicated, we've had prior hearings on this. I really want to thank you. I want to thank all the staff that worked very diligently on this. I also want to

acknowledge my staff, Joe Taranto who worked on this very extensively as well, and the advocacy community.

Again, this continues to really be more tools in the toolbox that we've been able to provide to tenants to really afford them protections. In mandating that individuals be name, that individual's numbers and addresses be listed in their registration documents is one way that tenants have to really hold landlords accountable. So landlords can no longer really hide behind these shell corporations and companies that they set up to own these buildings.

So I'm very excited. It took some time to get here, but we're all happy and can't wait for this committee to vote on it and then we have the ability to vote on it in the full council. As the chair said, I urge all my colleagues to vote yes on this bill. Thank you.
