Disabilities, and Addiction. I like to start by thanking my amazing colleagues for being on and present this early morning as we vote on a very important piece of legislation: Introduction number 2005-A which I am very proud to sponsor. This legislation would require the New York City
Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, also known as DOHMH, to track and issue a report on the mental health of New Yorkers during the COVID-19 public

COMMITTEE ON MENTAL HEALTH, DISABILITIES, AND 1 ADDICTIONS health emergency. Specifically, the report would be 2 3 published every six months and would include the 4 number of 311 calls relating to mental health, the number of 911 calls relating to mental health 5 emergencies, and substance misuse or overdoses. 6 7 number of call received by any mental health hotline 8 maintained by the Department or by another agency, as well as the number of hospital admissions for overdoses or substance use-related cases and any 10 11 other information relating to the mental health of New Yorkers during the COVID-19 public health 12 13 emergency that the Commissioner of Health deems 14 appropriate. Importantly, on an annual basis, the 15 report would also include a description of any trends 16 in adverse mental health of New Yorkers during the 17 COVID-19 public health emergency and any steps taken 18 by DOHMH to address such trends. I would like to 19 thank my colleagues, as well as my staff. 20 Legislative director Christia Winter, Alex Timkiff 21 [sp?], as well as our Council Committee staff, senior 2.2 counsel Sara Liss, legislative policy analyst Christy 2.3 Dryer, and our financial analyst Lauren Hunt, for all
