that will ceremonially co-name 199 Thoroughfares and

Public Places throughout the City. These co-naming

bills are the result of the Council's process where

we seek individuals and organizations that have made

lasting contributions to our city. Signs include co
names for active community members, heroic New

Yorkers who sacrificed their lives for others, people

who committed their lives to public service, or those

who (INAUDIBLE 1:37) enrich the City's cultural landscape.

Of the many people honored by this piece of legislation, I would like to call attention to a couple of co-naming's that I'm proud to have sponsored.

Sarah Whiting Way who was a long-time respected community leader and activist in Flushing and Ganesh Temple Street, which honors the Hindu Temple Society of North America, which is one of the first, if not the first, Hindu temple in North America.

Today, the Committee will also consider

Intro 2462 sponsored by my colleague, Council Member

Daneek Miller. This bill will officially rename St.

Albans Park in Queens to Archie Spigner Park. This

will honor the late Archie Spigner who represented

Southeast Queens with great distinction in the

Council from 1974 to 2001 and was a great trailblazer

in many ways.

I'm happy to support these bills, and I urge my Colleagues on the Committee to vote in favor of these pieces of legislation. If there are any of my Colleagues who would like to speak regarding these

community in Ozone Park. We're very proud to honor the block where he lived and rename that in his

Paul Russo. Paul Russo was a young man who died very young, 33 years old. I grew up with Paul. We played Little League together. His family owns Russo's on the Bay and the Villa Russo in Richmond Hill, a renowned local establishment. Paul fought a very brave and courageous battle with colorectal cancer, died several years ago, but to this day continues to inspire people to live a life greater than themselves and to give back to their communities.

And Clare Droesch who was just a phenomenal human being, a coach at Scholar's Academy in Rockaway, and somebody who inspired countless young women to achieve their full potential to reach for the stars. Definitely deserving of this honor.

There are so many other good people on the list. We can go on and on. But again I do want to just go on the record and, you know, just heap praise on some of these people. They are gone but definitely not forgotten. We are keeping their memories alive. We are honoring their legacies, and
