We have Yovan Samuel Collado, who is a Bronx resident, a registered member of the democratic party. Kristen Johnson is a Brooklyn resident and a registered member of the democratic party. Michael Schnall is a Staten Island resident and a registered member of the democratic party and Gregory Kirschenbaum is a Manhattan resident and a registered member of the democratic party.

New York City Charter Sections 50, 51 and 52 provide for the establishment of a districting commission. Following each districting commission is convened to withdraw City Council district lines to accurately reflect the city's population size and demographics. The Districting Commission consists of

15 members. Five members of the Council - of the five members by the City Council party conference, it's the largest delegation, which is this delegation that we are in right now. Three members by this council delegation with the second largest delegation

and seven members appointed by the Mayor.

Out of the party with the largest delegation, the Council democrats, there must be one member from each The Commission as a whole must have members borough. of the racial and language minority groups in New York City, which are protected by the United States Voting Rights Act in proportion to their population in the city as close as possible.

There is no compensation for Commission members. The Commission will end on January 6, 2024, upon adoption of a final redistricting plan and filing with the City Clerk and 60 days after the first general election of the Council with the lines. members of the Commission elect one of the 15 members as a Chair. The Commission may hire staff and may require city agencies to provide technical assistance. The members are prohibited from being officers or employees of the city, register lobbyists or employees of lobbyists or officers of any
