Transparency Resolution adds nine new initiatives and makes technical corrections to the designations listed in the Fiscal 2011 Schedule C. The resolution also makes changes to designations made in Fiscal 2010 expense budget. Council Members should have the list of these changes, and in some cases, additions, which is attached to the resolutions. For clarification purposes, it is to be noted that organizations appearing in the resolutions that have not yet completed the prequalification process conducted by the Mayor's Office of Contract Services by the Council or other government agencies are identified in the attached charts with an asterisk. Additionally, as with all Transparency Resolutions, Council

Members will have to sign the disclosure form, 2 indicating whether or not a conflict exists with 3 4 any of the groups attached on the list. If any council member has a potential conflict of 5 interest with any of the organizations listed, he 6 or she may want to disclose the conflict at the 7 8 time of their vote, and before they vote. I would like to remind Finance Committee members that next 9 Tuesday, October 5, at 11:00, in the 14<sup>th</sup> Floor 10 11 Hearing Room, the Finance Committee and the 12 Transportation Committee, will hold a hearing on 13 Proposed Intro 22-A, sponsored by Council Member Mike Nelson, which would establish a temporary 14 15 parking amnesty program. This bill would waive 16 the penalties and interest on unpaid parking 17 tickets that are two years old or older.
