candidates provided testimony and fielded questions
from council members.

Georgia Pestana is a resident of Manhattan and a candidate for appointment by the Comptroller of the Conflicts of Interest Board. If she receives advice and consent of the council, she will serve a six-year term that begins on April 1, 2022 and expires on March 31, 2028.

Ifeoma Ike is a resident of Brooklyn and a candidate for appointment by the Public Advocate to the Conflicts of Interest Board, if she receives the advice and consent of The City Council, she will serve a six-year term that begins on April 1, 2022 and expires on March 31, 2028.

I want to note on the record that Miss Ike submitted additional documentation following our hearing regarding the potential conflicts of interest that we had discussed at Monday's meeting. Those materials have been distributed to all members of the committee.
