- AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to photo speed violation monitoring systems in school speed zones in the city of New York; and to amend chapter 189 of the laws of 2013, amending the vehicle and traffic law and the public officers law relating to establishing in a city with a population of one million or more a demonstration program implementing speed violation monitoring systems in school speed zones by means of photo devices, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraphs 1 and 2 of subdivision (a) of section 1180-b of 2 the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 30 of the laws of 3 2019, are amended to read as follows:

1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the city of New York is 4 5 hereby authorized to establish a demonstration program imposing monetary liability on the owner of a vehicle for failure of an operator thereof 6 7 to comply with posted maximum speed limits in a school speed zone within such city [(i)] when a school speed limit is in effect as provided in 8 paragraphs one and two of subdivision (c) of section eleven hundred 9 eighty of this article or [(ii)] when other speed limits are in effect 10 11 as provided in subdivision (b), (d), (f) or (g) of section eleven 12 hundred eighty of this article [weekdays between the hours of six 13 o'clock A.M. and ten o'clock P.M]. Such demonstration program shall

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1 empower the city of New York to install photo speed violation monitoring 2 systems within no more than seven hundred fifty school speed zones with-3 in such city at any one time and to operate such systems within such zones [(iii)] when a school speed limit is in effect as provided in 4 paragraphs one and two of subdivision (c) of section eleven hundred 5 6 eighty of this article or [(iv)] when other speed limits are in effect 7 as provided in subdivision (b), (d), (f) or (g) of section eleven 8 hundred eighty of this article [weekdays between the hours of six o'clock A.M. and ten o'clock P.M]. In selecting a school speed zone in 9 which to install and operate a photo speed violation monitoring system, 10 11 the city of New York shall consider criteria including, but not limited 12 to, the speed data, crash history, and the roadway geometry applicable 13 to such school speed zone. Such city shall prioritize the placement of 14 photo speed violation monitoring systems in school speed zones based 15 upon speed data or the crash history of a school speed zone. A photo 16 speed violation monitoring system shall not be installed or operated on 17 a controlled-access highway exit ramp or within three hundred feet along 18 a highway that continues from the end of a controlled-access highway 19 exit ramp.

20 No photo speed violation monitoring system shall be used in a 2. 21 school speed zone unless (i) on the day it is to be used it has success-22 fully passed a self-test of its functions; and (ii) it has undergone an 23 annual calibration check performed pursuant to paragraph four of this 24 subdivision. The city shall install signs bearing the words "photo 25 enforced" below speed limit signs giving written notice to approaching motor vehicle operators that a photo speed violation monitoring system 26 27 is in use, in conformance with standards established in the MUTCD, and 28 shall modify existing signage to reflect such written notice in the 29 regular course of maintenance.

30 § 2. The opening paragraph of section 15 of chapter 189 of the laws of 31 2013, amending the vehicle and traffic law and the public officers law 32 relating to establishing in a city with a population of one million or 33 more a demonstration program implementing speed violation monitoring 34 systems in school speed zones by means of photo devices, as amended by 35 chapter 30 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as follows:

This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall have become a law and shall expire and be deemed repealed July 1, [2022] and provided further that any rules necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date shall be promulgated on or before such effective date, provided that:

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that the amendments to section 1180-b of the vehicle and traffic law made by section one of this act shall not affect the repeal of such section and shall be deemed repealed therewith.
