Introduced by COMMITTEE ON RULES -- (at request of M. of A. Walker) -read once and referred to the Committee on Cities

AN ACT to authorize the city of New York to discontinue the use as parkland a portion of real property in the borough of Brooklyn and to transfer such lands to the metropolitan transportation authority, to enable the New York city transit authority to construct in such areas new permanent at-grade station improvements and pedestrian bridges

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subject to the provisions of this act, but notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the city of New York is hereby authorized, upon such terms and conditions the city shall determine, to: (a) discontinue permanently the use as parklands the lands described in section three of this act, and transfer such lands to the metropolitan transportation authority, to enable the New York city transit authority to construct in such areas new permanent at-grade station improvements;
(b) discontinue permanently the air rights over the parklands described in section four of this act, and transfer such air rights to the metropolitan transportation authority for pedestrian bridges between and among the L, J, Z, A and C subway lines; and (c) discontinue temporarily the use as parklands the areas described in section five of this act for construction staging areas.
§ 2. The authorization provided in section one of this act shall be effective only upon the condition that at the time of the transfer of the lands and air rights described in sections three and four of this act, the city of New York dedicates as parkland the lands described in section six of this act provided that the city of New York has never used such lands for public open space or park purposes. In the event that such land to be dedicated is not equal to or greater than the fair market value of the park land to be discontinued, the city of New York shall dedicate the difference between the fair market value of the park land to be discontinued and the fair market value of the land to be dedicated towards the acquisition of new parklands or capital improve-

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ments to existing parklands and recreational facilities within the borough of Brooklyn.
§ 3. The lands hereby authorized by section one of this act to be discontinued permanently as parkland and transferred to the metropolitan transportation authority are located in the county of Kings, city and state of New York in a park known as the Callahan-Kelly Park, and are bounded and described as follows:

§ 5. The lands hereby authorized to be discontinued temporarily as parklands by section one of this act and granted as temporary easements to serve as construction staging areas for the duration of construction are bounded and described as follows:

Said parcel containing 8,564 square feet ( 0.20 acres) of land more or less.
§ 6. The lands hereby authorized to be dedicated as parklands by the city of New York on the terms set forth in section two of this act are located in the county of Kings, city and state of New York and bounded and described as follows:

Portion of Sackman Street abutting Tax Lot 1 in Block 1546, Borough of Brooklyn:

Beginning at the Point of Commencement, ( $\mathrm{N}=186378.8532$, $E=1009899.0749$ ) (NAD83) at the corner formed by the intersection of the northerly line of Fulton Street, an eighty feet width right of way, and the north-easterly line of Eastern Parkway, a one-hundred- and ten-feet width right of way, running thence,

Easterly along the said northerly sideline of Fulton Street 466.90' to the Point of Beginning on the same northerly sideline of Fulton Street, and the easterly sideline of sackman street, thence,

1) Along the easterly sideline of Sackman Street in a general northerly direction having an interior angle of $74^{\circ} 27^{\prime \prime} 51^{\prime \prime}$ with the previous course $124.23^{\prime}$ to a point along the southerly sideline of Truxton Street a 70' width right of way, thence,
2) Along the southerly sideline of Truxton Street in a general westerly direction having an interior angle of $92^{\circ} 50^{\prime \prime \prime \prime \prime \prime}$ with the previous course 80.10' to a point on the same southerly sideline of Truxton Street and the westerly sideline of Sackman street, thence,

Said parcel containing 10,968 square feet ( 0.25 acres) of land more or less.
§ 7. In the event that the city of New York received any funding, support or assistance from the federal government for the purchase, maintenance or improvement of the park lands set forth in sections three, four and five of this act, the discontinuance and alienation of such parkland authorized by the provisions of this act shall not occur until the city of New York has complied with any federal requirements pertaining to the alienation or conversion of such park lands, including satisfying the secretary of the interior that the alienation or conversion complies with all conditions which the secretary of the interior deems necessary to assure the substitution of other lands shall be equivalent in fair market value and usefulness to the lands being alienated or converted.
§ 8. Upon the completion of construction, the metropolitan transportation authority shall, in agreement with the city of New York and in consultation with the local community board, restore the surface of the lands described in section five of this act and the lands shall otherwise continue to be used for park purposes.
§ 9. This act shall take effect immediately.
