have routinely failed inspections and submit a plan

to the Council on how the issues at such parks and playgrounds will be corrected.

Regarding data from The Park Inspection Program, recent years saw a trend of overall conditions and cleanliness features averaging acceptable ratings in the high 80's and low 90's percentage wise. However, the most recent data indicates a slight drop since 2019, which is concerning. I think this bill can help us go a long way in being able to identify the areas of our Parks system that are need in greater resources, and allow us the mechanism for targeting those resources to the areas with the greatest need.

As we have heard many times in, and discussed through our hearings as well, especially in our last hearing on Parks Equity, if we are to be a system where everyone has access to well-maintained, high quality green space, it requires ensuring at a very basic level, that all parks across our New York City Parks system are taken care of, that they have the resources to do so, and follow a timely schedule for maintenance and repair work.

This bill will ensure and help to achieve that goal, and as such it is a crucial component of
