of an R6A district to better reflect the surrounding community character of small 1 and 2-family homes. We will also reduce the rezoning area to concentrate the increased density at the intersection of 2 wide streets and in recognition of the applicant's commitment to provide a community facility use such as an urgent care medical office. The proposes C2-2 commercial overlay would remain in place over the full block frontage to bring existing businesses into compliance with zoning. I'll note that as discussed by the Zoning Subcommittee, earlier this week the applicant withdrew the proposed companion text amendment as it would be inapplicable to an R5B zoning district, and that pursuant to Council rule 11.60B preconsidered LU 40 was withdrawn. The associated application is void, and we will be filing LU 40 to remove it from our calendar.

We will also vote to approve with modifications LUs 41 and 42 for the 103 Lee Avenue rezoning proposal relating to property in Council Member Restler's district. The proposal would rezone an existing R6 and R6/C1-3 districts to an R7X/C2-4 district as well as establish an MIH program area utilizing MIH Options 1 and 2. Our modification will

remove the 100 Lee Avenue site from the rezoning area to avoid incentivizing the direct displacement of existing neighborhood retail and service businesses currently located at the site.

We will also vote to approve LU 46 for the Broadway Triangle-Bartlett Crossing proposal, also related to property in Council Member Restler's district. This is an HPD application pursuant to Article 16 of the General Municipal Law and Section 197-C of the New York City Charter requesting a designation of Urban Development Action Area, approval of an Urban Development Action Area project for such area, and approval of the disposition of city-owned property to a developer to be selected by HPD.

We will also vote to approve LU 47 for the 2300 Cropsey Avenue rezoning related to property in Council Member Brannan's district. This proposal would map a C2-4 overlay within an existing R6 district.

We will also vote to approve LUs 48 and 49 for the 35-01 Vernon Boulevard rezoning proposal relating to property in Council Member Won's district. This proposal would rezone an existing R5
