pounding). Thank you and good morning and welcome to today's vote. My name is Diana Ayala and I am a Deputy Speaker of the New York City Council and the Chair of the General Welfare Committee. Today our Committee will vote on legislation that I am proud to sponsor, intro number 212B which is a local law to amend the Administrative Code of the City of New York in relation to updating the report on utilization of the applications for multi-agency emergency housing assistance, exits from city-administered facilities and financings, starts and completion of permanent housing for those exiting city-administered facilities. This bill would require the monthly

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report now required by Local Law 37 of 2011 to be updated to include information on the total number of all individuals utilizing emergency housing in the City and the total number of families with adults, with children, adult families, single men and single women utilizing temporary housing, emergency housing. Additionally this Bill would require the Mayor's Office of Operation to report on the exits from various City-Administered Facilities including the Department of Youth and Community Development, the Department of Homeless Services, the Department of Housing Preservation and Development and the Human Service Resource Administration. Finally this Bill would require the Mayor's Office of Operation to report on the financings, starts and completions of permanent housing for those exiting to the Administered Facilities. I would also like to point out that I would be introducing a Bill shortly that will ensure the report required by this Bill would not include Justice Involved supportive housing in the Comp for Emergency Shelter. As we all know supportive housing is a permanent affordable housing and we will ensure that it is counted as such. will be a technical amendment to this Bill that will

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2	not change the substance. Intro Number 212B will
3	make it easier to understand the scope of home
4	services in New York City and better assess gaps that
5	may exist and I would like to thank the advocates,
