COMMITTEE COUNSEL MARTINEZ-RUBIO: Thank you, Counsel. Today, we will vote to approve Preconsidered LUs 79 and 80 related to 77-39 Vleigh Place Rezoning proposal in Queens, Council District represented by Council Member Gennaro.

The proposal includes a zoning map amendment to rezone an existing R3-2/C1-2 district to an R6A/C2-3 district and a related zoning text amendment to establish an MIH program area utilizing Option 1 and 2.

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The Council's modifications will be to reduce the density of the proposed development from the proposed R6A district to an R6B district. The proposed development with this modification will be more in context with the existing character of the neighborhood, which is characterized by a mix of 3-to 4-story multifamily buildings and smaller so 1-to 2-family homes while still creating permanently affordable housing units under MIH. Council Member Gennaro is in support of the proposal which has been modified.

We will also vote to approve with modifications Preconsidered LUs 81 and 82 relating to the 11th Street and 34th Avenue Rezoning proposal in Council Member Won's district in Queens.

The proposal would rezone an existing R5 district to an M1-5/R6A district and a related zoning text amendment to establish a special mixed-use district with special height and setback regulations as well as establish an MIH program area utilizing Options 1 and 2.

The Council's modification will be to strike MIH Option 2. Council Member Won is in support of the proposal as modified.

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We will also vote to approve with
modifications Preconsidered LUs 83 and 84 relating to
Wetherole Street and 67th Avenue Rezoning in Council
Member Schulman's district in Queens.

The proposal would rezone an existing R4B district to an R6A district and the related zoning text amendment to establish an MIH program area utilizing Options 1 and 2.

The Council's modifications will be to strike MIH Option 2. Council Member Schulman is in support of the proposal.
