Counsel. Today, we will vote to approve Preconsidered

LUS under ULURP numbers C 220203 ZMX and N 220204 ZRX

related to the 1810 Randall Avenue rezoning proposed

in Council Member Farias' district in the Bronx. The

proposal will rezone the existing R4 and R5 zoning

districts to an R6, reduce an existing C1-2 overlay

district, and establish an MIH program area utilizing

MIH Options 1 and 2. These actions will facilitate

the development of a new 8-story mixed-use building

with an upgraded house of worship facility. I will

now hand this over to Council Member Farias for her

remarks.

COUNCIL MEMBER FARIAS: Thank you so much,
Chair Salamanca. Today, the Land Use Committee is
voting on a very important project in the Soundview
community which I represent and was born and raised.
The project at 1810 Randall Avenue is one that I have
been working on since the fall of 2021, before I was
even officially sworn in as a Council Member. This is
a project I am very proud to support, and I would
like to applaud the stakeholders involved in this

development for their commitment to the community and its needs.

Throughout this process, Casa De La Fe, the developers, and the community have worked together to create a plan that would bring much needed affordable senior housing to the area while allowing the church, a staple in our community, to remain in this location. I cannot underscore enough how necessary affordable senior housing is in Council District 18, which has a large population of Bronxites aging in place. This building will be 100 percent affordable senior housing financed through the SARA program with a rolling voucher for every one of the 167 units.

In addition to housing, the developers are committed to building the church a new space on the ground floor which they will own, investments into the local community garden, and a community center to serve the surrounding neighborhood. Because of the community's need for this type of development, I have allocated 1.5 million from my capital budget for FY-23 to ensure that this project will build a great building that breaks ground this year.
