introduction will amend the energy code of the

10 City of New York.

would establish an energy code that is more stringent than the one the State of New York recently adopted. In 2009, this legislative body and City established an energy code with the enactment of Local Law 85. However, in April of this year, as I previously stated, the New York State Fire Prevention and Building Code Council amended the New York State Energy Code in its entirety by adopting the 2009 edition of the International Energy Conservation Code, which is a model code published by the International Code Council.

The New York State amendments are scheduled to take effect on December 28th of this

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2	year. So in order for New York City to maintain
3	its own energy code, the City must establish an
4	energy code that is more stringent than that of
5	the State of New York. The proposed legislation
6	before us would do exactly that.

On November 13th this committee
held a hearing and received testimony on the
legislation before us and received testimony from
officials from the Department of Buildings as well
as representatives from real estate and the
construction industries. The bill has been
amended from its original version and the list of
the amendments can be found on pages 15 and 16 of
the Committee Report. And with that I'd like to
ask my colleagues to vote in favor of the bill and
have the clerk call the roll.
