Before we begin, I want to first remind my colleagues; today is the Council's Charter Meeting, which is the Council's first Stated Meeting of a calendar year. The Charter Meeting begins at noon rather than the usual time of 1:30, so please try to be on time.

Now, let's go down to business.

Today, the Council will formally begin the Fiscal

2012 budget cycle. We will begin the cycle by

considering a piece of legislation which we

typically consider at the start of each budget

cycle.

Under the Charter, the

Administration has until January 16th of each year
to submit their preliminary budget to the Council.

If the Mayor does not believe he can comply with
the Charter-mandated date, then he must submit
legislation to the Council amending the Charter
dates.

Today's Intro would extend the dates related to the Fiscal 2012 preliminary budget. The Mayor has requested and extension to allow the Administration time to review the

2 Governor's budget which is slated to be released 3 on or about February 1st.

Today's Intro would give the Mayor an additional four weeks, until February 17th, to submit the preliminary budget, and would extend the dates for preliminary budget actions taken by other agencies, such as: IBO, Department of Finance, the City Planning Commission and other officials such as the borough presidents.

The Proposed Local Law also extends the deadline for the Council's preliminary budget hearings and budget responsible from March 25th to April 8th. Finally, the Proposed Local Law also extends the deadline for the Mayor to submit the preliminary management report and the deadline for submission of the draft 10-Year Capital Strategy Plan, which is submitted each other year.

This legislation is the only item on our agenda this morning. This meeting will be adjourned after we vote on this legislation. Does anybody have any questions? Jimmy Oddo will take the questions. Seeing no questions, could we please call the vote? I recommend everybody vote aye.
