Eric A. Ulrich James S. Oddo everyone and happy New Year. I'd like to call this committee hearing to order. My name is Erik Dilan and I'm the Chair of the City Council's

Housing and Buildings Committee.

Today, the committee will conduct the first hearing of the year, for the purposes of a vote on Intro 436-A, which is a Local Law to amend the Administrative Code of the City of New York in relation to our Alternative Enforcement Program.

This bill would amend the Safe
Housing Act, which is Local Law 29 of 2007. In
May of 2007, the Safe Housing Act was passed by
this Council, which was then Intro 561-A, and
became Local Law 29 of that year.

The Safe Housing Act was intended to improve the Department of Housing Preservation and Development's Code Enforcement Program. The committee heard and received testimony, on the original version of this legislation that we are voting on today, on December 15th. We heard testimony at that time from representatives of HPD, as well as tenants, housing advocates and

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2 representatives of the real estate industry.

The bill proposed before us would revise the AEP program in certain respects by revising the program's building selection criteria, which we expect will increase the total number of dwelling units that the program captures. It'll incorporate provisions specifically related to addressing mold and vermin conditions in multiple dwellings. The program, additionally, will be amended to allow buildings that are in the program to be more readily discharged.

This bill will also allow owners who have substantially complied with repair requirements to enter into payment agreements for outstanding fees and fines for emergency repair charges, as opposed to requiring that all such charges be paid in full before a building is discharged from the program.

A summary of the amendments of the legislation on Intro 436 can be found on pages 11 and 12 in the Committee Report. I urge my colleagues to vote in favor of the legislation. I would like to ask the clerk to call the roll.
