On January 5, 6 and 14, I transmitted a total of six local laws to your office. A copy of these letters with a City Council date stamp is attached. Since Local Laws 4 - 6 (Introductory Numbers 343-A, 396-A and 428-A) were signed by the Mayor prior to Local Laws 1 -3 (Introductory Numbers 257-A, 437 and 442) the Law Department has recommended that they be renumbered so that they are ordered chronologically.
