The New York City School Construction Authority has undertaken the site selection process for a new, approximately 252-seat Early Childhood Center located at Virginia Avenue, Block 28-47, lot 84, 85, 86, and block 28-48, lot 34, in the borough of Staten Island. The site is 52,485 square feet, approximately 1.2 acres. The property is part of the former St Mary's Church complex, consisting of a vacant school building and a paved parking lot. The site is located within Staten Island community district number 1 and community district number 31, the Rosebank neighborhood of Staten Island.

The notice of filing for the site was published in the New York Post and City Record on December 28, 2020, at which time Community Education Council number 31, Staten Island Community Board Number 1, and the City Planning Commission were also notified of the site plan. The Community Education Council and community boards were asked to hold public

2 hearings on the proposed site plan. Staten Island

3 Community Board 1 held a public hearing on January

4 12, 2021. Community Education Council number 31 held

5 a public hearing on January 4, 2021. No public

6 comments were received. The SCA affirms the site

7 plan, pursuant to Section 1731 of the New York Public

8 Authorities Law, in accordance with Section 1732 of

9 the PAL, the SCA submitted the proposed site plan to

MR. CONA: Correct, and the pink... the pink lots are the specific lots that we are requiring for this property. Next.
