I want to welcome my esteemed colleagues who have joined us today. We've been — alright, I've been told that there's some technical difficulties, so just give us two minutes.

Alright, thank you. Alright, good morning and welcome to the Committee on Land Use. I am Council Member Rafael Salamanca, Chair of this Committee. I want to welcome my esteemed colleagues who have joined us today. We've been joined by Council Member Chair Louis, Chair Riley, Council Member Brooks-Powers, Bottcher, Hanks, Kagan and Borelli.

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And we've also been joined by remotely by Council

Member Sanchez and Council Member Moya.

I would like to thank Chair Louis and Chair
Riley for their work on our two Subcommittees.
We've also been joined by Council Member Krishnan.
Before we begin today's meeting, I would like to
recognize the Committee Counsel to review the
hearing procedures.

COMMITTEE COUNSEL: Thank you Chair Salamanca.

I am Arthur Huh, Counsel to this Committee. Council

Members who are physically present and you would

We ask all participants for your continued patience should any technical difficulties arise and Chair Salamanca will now continue with today's agenda items.

CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: Thank you Counsel.

Today, we'll vote to approve the Preconsidered LU's related to Application Number G 220026 CCM for an amendment to the previously approved Council

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Resolution 261 of 2022 for the 34 Morningside Avenue

ANCP Cluster, related to property in Council Member

Richardson Jordans District in Manhattan.

We will also move to approve LU's 155 for the 97-27 57th Avenue Rezoning Proposal related to property in Council Member Moya's District in Queens. The proposal consists of a Zoning Map Amendment to map a C2-4 Overlay with an existing R6A C1-2 in R6B districts.

We will also vote to disapprove LU's 156 and 157 for the 58-02 Northern Boulevard Rezoning Proposal, related to property in Council Member Won's District in Queens. As proposed, the Application saw a Zoning Map Amendment to rezone the R5 Zoning District to an R6B C2-2 Zoning district together with a related MIH Zoning Text Amendment.

As we heard during the public testimony in our hearing, Northern Boulevard is oversaturated with cars, dealerships and other auto related uses.

Where the Council would support a more comprehensive balance and community-led approach for the future of the corridor.

Queens Community Board 2 recently passed a Resolution in support of this approach. Favoring a

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community-led mixed-use neighborhood plan including affordable housing in a redesigned Northern Boulevard.

We will also vote to approve with modifications LU's 158 and 159 for the 446-448 Park Avenue Rezoning Proposal, related to property in Council Member Restler's District in Brooklyn. The Application includes a Zoning Map Amendment to rezone an existing M1-1 Zoning District to an M1-4/R6A Zoning District in a related MIA Zoning Text Amendment. A modification will be to strike MIH Option 2 while retaining Option 1.

We will also vote to approve with modifications LU's 160 and 161 for the Reform Temple of Forest Hills Rezoning Proposal related to property in Council Member Schulman's District in Queens. The Application seeks a Zoning Map Amendment to rezone an R1-2A Zoning District to an R7D Zoning District and a related MIA Zoning Text Amendment. A modification will be to strike MIH Option 2 while retaining Option 1.

We will also vote to approve LU's 162, a request by HPD for a Resolution and support of a grant application under the restored New York communities

3 Member Hanif's District in Brooklyn. The

4 application seeks capital funding from the Empire

5 State Development Corporation for up to \$5 million

6 to facilitate the Gowanus Green Affordable Housing
