CHAIRPERSON WILLIAMS: Welcome to the vote of the Queens Delegation of the New York City

The Taxi and Limousine Commission or TLC is the agency responsible for licensing and regulating taxis, for-hire vehicles, commuter vans, and powered transit vehicles. The Commission's Board consists of eight unsalaried members and one salaried Commissioner appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council. The City's Charter requires that five of the Commission's members represent one of each of the five boroughs and gives the Council's borough delegations the role of recommending the Mayor's nominee of their borough's representative on the Commission through a majority vote.

Today, we will be voting on the Mayor's appointment, or essentially our appointment, for TLC's Queens representative Paul Bader. These challenges call for a nominee that will prioritize the needs of the public. Paul Bader is a Queens resident and small business owner. He has experience that will serve him well in looking out for the many small businesses that make up TLC's industry. Paul also has a long record of public and community service including time spent working at the Council and under multiple New York City Comptrollers. Paul also has direct experience with the needs of drivers as he has worked both as a New York City taxi driver and a truck driver. For these reasons, I support this nominee to the TLC and also recommend that my Colleagues vote yes to support this nomination.

I will now turn it over to my Co-Chair to conduct the official vote.
