3	I want to thank everyone for being here on time.
4	I want to thank the Republicans for being here. I
5	want to thank the Dominican Caucus [phonetic] for
6	being here, early.

9	CHAIRPERSON RECCHIA: On time.
10	Okay. You ready, Jerry? Good morning, welcome to
11	this morning's Finance Committee hearing. My name
12	is Domenic M. Recchia, Jr. I am the Chair of the
13	Committee. Today on our agenda are five Land Use
14	items, most of which are seeking a property tax
15	exemption from HPD. We have HPD present here
16	today. Under section 577 of the private rental
17	housing finance law, which covers rental housing,
18	development fund companies or simply, HDFCs.
19	The first item is the Haven Plaza
20	in Council Member Rosie Mendez's district. Haven
21	Plaza contains four buildings that provide 371

units of rental housing for low-income families.
The sponsor Haven Plaza Housing Development Fund
Company seeking to finance significant rehab work
with a combination of an Article 8 mortgage loan

3	Development Corporation. Council Member Mend	.ez
1	supports this.	

Next we have the Concord Senior
Residence in Council Member Al Vann's district.
This item is a multiple dwelling that provides 30
units of rental housing for the elderly. The
sponsor Concord Senior Citizens Housing
Development Fund Corp is seeking new property tax
exemption for the continuance of affordable
housing to lower-income seniors. Council Member
Vann supports this.

The next item is the 105th Street

Homestead it is in Council Member Melissa Mark
Viverito's district. This building contains seven

multiple dwellings that provides 44 units of co-op

housing for low-income families. Due to high

increases in assessed values of the expiration of

a J51 tax abatement, the sponsor 105th Homesteads

Housing Development Fund Corp is now requesting a

partial 30 year tax exempt pursuant to Section 577

of the Private Housing Finance Law in order to

ensure affordability to low-income families.

Council Member Melissa Mark-Viverito supports this

2 item.

The next item is the Metro North
Gardens, which is also in Council Member Melissa
Mark-Viverito's district. The building contains
one multiple dwelling that provides 48 units of
rental housing for low-income families. The
sponsor Metro North Gardens housing Development
Fund will finance the rehab of the project with a
loan from the New York City Housing Development
Corp. Council Member Melissa Mark-Viverito
supports this.

Our last item is the Culver El located in Council Member Lander's district. This building will be a new construction project consists of 68 condos for sale to low-income purchasers and the development of 48 parking spaces for existing community facilities adjacent to proposed housing development. The project will be developed under HPD's New Foundation Program, which would allow a yet to be determined sponsor to purchase city-owned and construct affordable one to four family homes or condos. The City provides federal funds as a form of down payment assistance. It is also requesting a 20 year tax

25	can get the much needed repair to the over 300

2	residents who live in these buildings. I want to
3	thank my Speaker, my colleagues and all the staff
4	for all their hard work for getting this through
5	the Council on various occasions and we are
6	closing on the loan, so we are all very happy.
