I'm New York City Council Member Chi Osse. My 10 11 pronouns are he/him/his. I'm Chair of the Committee on Cultural Affairs, Libraries and International 12 13 Intergroup Relations. 14 Today, the Committee will vote on one 15 piece of legislation, Resolution 515, co-sponsored by 16 Council Members Nantasha Williams, Amanda Farias, 17 Shekar Krishnan, and Shahana Hanif, a resolution 18 recognizing the month of Ramadan annually in the City 19 of New York and celebrating the significant role of 20 Muslims in the multicultural fabric of New York City communities. 21 New York City is home to thousands of 2.2 23 Muslims who later this month will be observing Ramadan, a holy month for Muslims dedicated to 24 spiritual reflection and community. Muslim New Yorkers make up a huge part of 3 4 the cultural identity that is New York City and play a significant role in shaping the vibrant diversity 5 that makes this City great. 6 7 I want to recognize and thank the Resolution's four sponsors, Council Members Williams, 8 9 Farias, Hanif, and Krishnan. Finally, I would like to thank my Staff 10 as well as the Committee Staff and others who worked 11 12 on preparing this legislation today including Naomi 13 Hopkins, my Chief-of-Staff, May Vutrapongvatana, my Budget and Policy Director, Brenda McKinney, Senior 14 15 Counsel to the Committee, Regina Paul, Legislative 16 Policy Analyst to the Committee who also drafted this 17 Resolution, and Sandra Gray, our Senior Financial 18 Analyst. COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Dinowitz. 6 7 COUNCIL MEMBER DINOWITZ: Aye. 8 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Farias. 9 COUNCIL MEMBER FARIAS: Permission to explain my vote. Reso 515 has been long anticipated 10 11 by our Muslim community citywide. Today, Reso 515 is 12 being voted on, and this would recognize the month of 13 Ramadan annually in the City of New York and 14 celebrate the significant contributions of our Muslim 15 communities throughout New York City. 9 percent of our city's population is Muslim, and New York City 16 17 represents 22 percent of all Muslims living in the 18 United States. Ramadan is the most sacred month in 19 Islamic culture, and New York City needs to respect 20 that with a formal recognition of this holiday. This 21 Resolution is long overdue, and I'm proud and happy 2.2 to have worked with my Colleagues, Council Members 23 Williams, Krishnan, and Hanif to make sure this year we finally vote it in to our City Charter. With that, 24 25 I vote aye.
