2 SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: This is a sound check 3 for the Committee on General Welfare. Today's date is 4 June 22, 2023. Being recorded by Danny Huong 5 (phonetic) in the Committee Room. 6 SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Good morning and 7 welcome to the New York City Council vote of the 8 Committee on General Welfare. 9 At this time, can everybody please 10 silence your cell phones. Thank you for your 11 cooperation. 12 Chair, we are ready to begin. 13 CHAIRPERSON AYALA: [GAVEL] Good morning, 14 everyone. Good morning and welcome to today's 15 hearing. My name is Diana Ayala, and I am the Deputy Speaker of the New York City Council and the Chair of 16 17 the General Welfare Committee. 18 Today, our Committee will be voting on 19 Proposed Intro. 561B sponsored by Council Member 20 Hudson. Proposed Intro. 561B would authorize the City to establish or fund one or more pilot programs to 21 22 provide direct cash assistance to certain eligible 23 low-income individuals. As I mentioned when we heard 24 the bill a few weeks ago, we know how difficult it is 25 to make ends meet in this city. We know how rampant

poverty is. Even before the pandemic, half of the 2 3 city's population lived below the poverty line. The economic pressures of the pandemic could have pushed 4 New Yorkers even further into poverty, but, 5 thankfully, every level of government stepped up to 6 7 strengthen the safety net, preventing disaster from hitting many individuals and families. That pandemic 8 support, which was intended to be temporary, is 9 quickly coming to an end. What we saw with the 10 11 pandemic (INAUDIBLE) policies including expansion of 12 unemployment insurance, SNAP and childcare tax credit 13 is that anti-poverty tools do work. It is with this 14 in mind that we are voting on Proposed Intro. 561B 15 today, which would support New Yorkers by authorizing the City to establish a pilot program for the 16 provision of unconditional direct cash payments. 17 I want to thank the advocates and the 18 19 individuals with lived experience that have informed 20 and helped us shape this legislation. 21 At this time, I'd like to acknowledge my 2.2 Colleagues who are here with us today, Council 23 Members Hudson, Osse, Stevens, Ung, and Williams. Also, I would like to thank the Committee 24 Staff who worked to prepare this hearing and finalize 25
